


Indian equity markets declined as investor caution intensified ahead of the U.S. tariff deadline scheduled for later this week. Considerable uncertainty remains over whether India will face increased tariffs starting in Aug 2025 or if the U.S. President will announce another extension.

Bharat Electronics Ltd (BEL) reported results for the first quarter ended Jun 2025, posting a 25% YoY increase in standalone profit after tax (PAT) at Rs. 969.13 crore, compared to Rs. 776.14 crore in the corresponding quarter last year. Revenue from operations rose 5.2% YoY to Rs. 4,416.83 crore, up from Rs. 4,198.77 crore recorded in the same period of the previous fiscal.

Tesla's CEO announced that the U.S. automaker has signed a chip supply agreement with Samsung Electronics. The move is expected to boost the South Korean tech giant's struggling contract manufacturing division.

Adani Green Energy reported a 60% YoY growth in its Q1FY26 consolidated net profit at Rs. 713 crore, compared to Rs. 446 crore in the same period last year. The profit is attributable to the shareholders of the company. Power supply-driven revenue jumped 31% YoY to Rs. 3,312 crore in Q1FY26, up from Rs. 2,528 crore in the year-ago period.





